## ASSESSMENT POLICY GRADE XI

1. Each academic year is divided into two terms **TERM-1 & TERM-II.**
2. Assessment in each term has two elements:
  - a. **Scholastic** – Including compulsory subjects and skill-based electives

*Scholastic assessment comprises of 2 important parts:*

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT	WEIGHTAGE IN EACH TERM
SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENT	80 % OR 70 %
FORMATIVE ASSESSMENT	20 % OR 30%

- b. **Co-Scholastic**- Art Education, Health and Physical Education (Sports/Da One/Yoga etc.) to be marked internally only.

- **Computer Science (083)**
  - ✓ Same 70 + 30
  - ◆ Includes **Python programs + Project file + Viva**
- **Physical Education (048)**
  - ✓ Same 70 + 30
  - ◆ Practical includes **fitness test + game skill + viva**
- **Painting (049)**
  - ✓ Same 30 (Theory) + 70 (Practical)
  - ◆ More focus on **portfolio + composition work**
