

ASSESSMENT POLICY GRADE III TO V

2026-27

1. Each academic year is divided into two terms **TERM-1 & TERM-II.**
2. Assessment in each term has two elements:

a. Scholastic –

For Grade 3 - Compulsory subjects are English, Hindi, Mathematics and Environmental Studies.

For Grades 4 and 5 - Compulsory subjects are English, Hindi, Mathematics, Environmental Studies and Third Language (French or Sanskrit)

Scholastic assessment comprises of 2 important parts:
