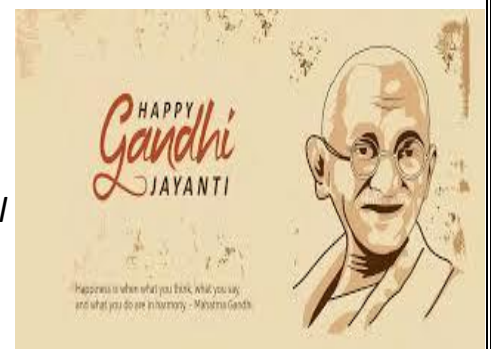

**Time- Activity Period (1.15 pm)**




## 5. 21st OCTOBER 2020 (WEDNESDAY) – DUSSEHRA

Symbolizing the victory of good over evil, the festival's name is derived from the Sanskrit words Dasha 'ten' and Hara 'defeat'.
